

## Create and Place a Video Carousel on a Web Page

YouTube videos provide interactive content to build engagement with users on our website. A Video Carousel block is designed to present three or more YouTube videos on any webpage of our site. Each video file also contains related content (media links, headlines, and descriptions). Be sure to have this information available before you start.

Creating a Video Carousel is easily done through the Content Management System, and involves three steps:

1. Create an **Icon Grid Item** for each YouTube video you want to display.
2. Create a **Video Carousel block** to display a group of Icon Grid Items.
3. Place the **Video Carousel block** on a webpage.

### Create an Icon Grid Item

1. Navigate to Content > Add Content > Icon Grid Item to create an **Icon grid item** for each featured video.
2. Add Title, Icon, YouTube URL and Description:

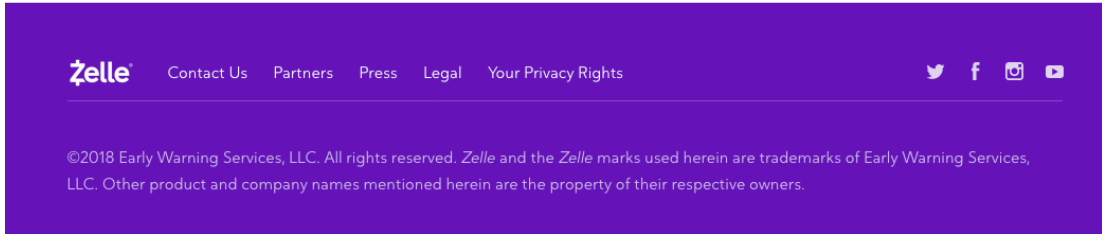
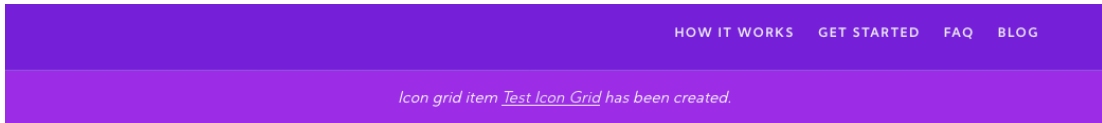

3. Save the Icon Grid Item. You should see a block similar to this:



After you have created all the necessary Icon grid items (one for each video), the next step is to create a Video Carousel block.

## Create a Video Carousel block

1. Navigate to Structure > Block Layout > + Add Custom Block > Video Carousel
2. Add Block Description, Title and Body Description (leave Title font as Thin):

3. In the “Use Existing Media” section, enter the names of the Icon Grid Items you created earlier:

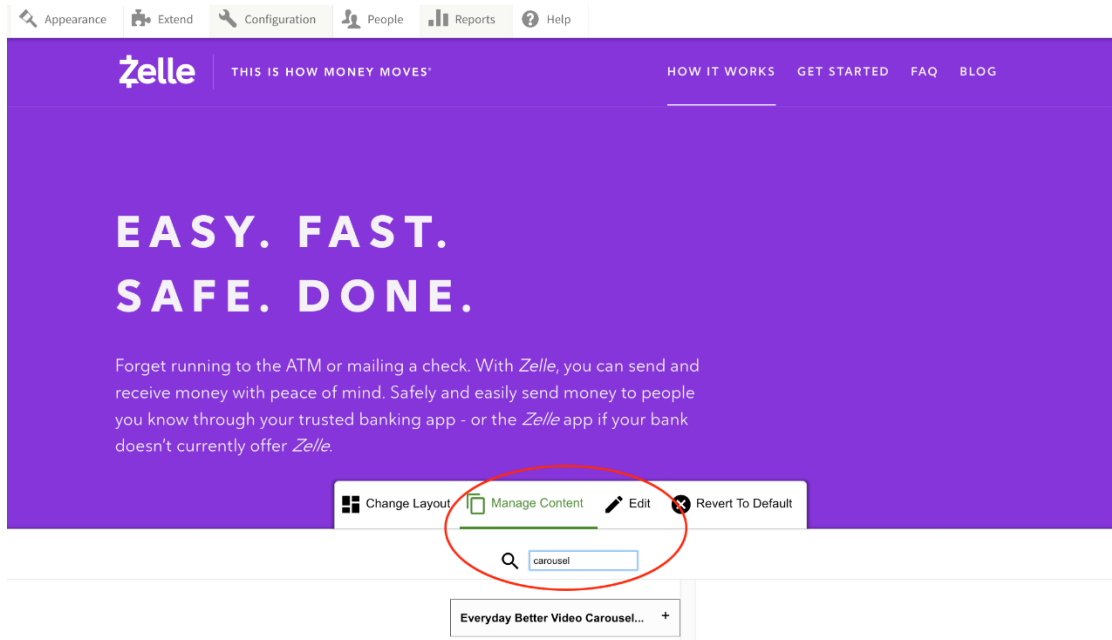

4. Save the Video Carousel. You’re now ready to place the block on a webpage.

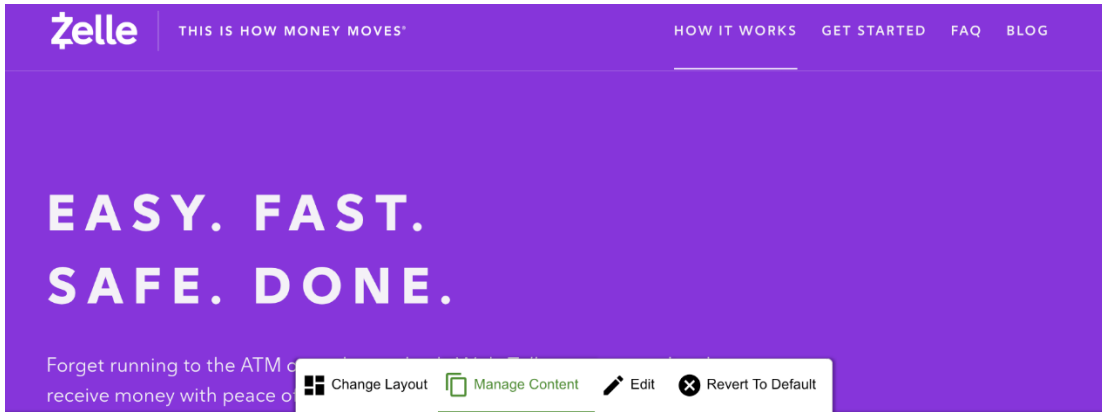
## Place the Video Carousel on a Webpage

To place the video carousel on a webpage:

1. Navigate to the desired webpage and select “Manage Content” from the bottom of the display.
2. You can filter available content by entering the title of your Video Carousel block in the search field as shown below:



3. Blocks that match your filter criteria will display below the search field.
4. Verify the title in the edit screen matches the title of the desired Video Carousel block.
5. Deselect the “Display Title” checkbox and make sure the Region dropdown equals “Content”. See screenshot below:

6. When all the settings are correct, select "Add".
7. The CMS will save the block with the Video Carousel block you selected.
8. The page should refresh and display your Video Carousel block similar to the image below:
